7.1 Evaluation Process

Capacity Building Commission shall evaluate the responses to this RFQ cum RFP and scrutinize the supporting documents / documentary evidence. Inability to submit the requisite supporting documents / documentary evidence, may lead to rejection. The decision of the Capacity Building Commission in the evaluation of proposals shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of evaluation with the Capacity Building Commission. Capacity Building Commission may ask for meetings with the Bidders to seek clarifications or conformations on their proposals. During the Bid Evaluation, Capacity Building Commission reserves the right to reject any or all the Proposals. Each of the responses/ Proposals shall be evaluated as per the criteria and requirements specified in this RFQ cum RFP.

Bidders will be classified in two tiers (1 & 2). **Tier I** bidders needs to fulfill the prequalification criteria as stipulated in **Annexure 2** of the corrigendum. **Tier II** bidders would be DPIIT recognized startups (Refer DoE OM No. F.1/7/2021-PPD-2 dated 2nd August 2021).

The steps for evaluation are as follows:

7.1.1 Stage 1: Pre-Qualification

- a) Capacity Building Commission shall open Cover 1 of the bidders Tier wise.
- b) If the contents of the Cover 1 are as per requirements and the EMD (Bid Securing Declaration) and Integrity Pact in prescribed format have been received in online format by the Capacity Building Commission as per the terms of this RFQ cum RFP, the Capacity Building Commission shall open "Cover 2". Eachof the Pre-Qualification conditions mentioned in Section 8 (Pre-Qualification Criteria) is MANDATORY. In case the Bidder does not meet any one of the conditions, the bidder will be disqualified. (Exemption will be applicable as mentioned in Section 8, point (b)).
- c) Response to the Pre-Qualification Requirements will be evaluated in accordance with the requirements specified in this RFQ cum RFP. A checklist must be created with proper page-wise indexing of all supporting documents.
- d) Results of the Pre-Qualification Bid opening will be intimated to bidders.

7.1.2 Stage 2: Technical Evaluation

- a) Cover 3 marked as "Technical bid" will be opened only for Bidders who succeed in Stage 1.
- b) For both the tiers, the bidders' technical solutions proposed in the bid

document will be evaluated as per **t**erequirements specified in this RFQ cum RFP and technical evaluation framework as mentioned in **Annexure – 3** of corrigendum.

Each Technical Bid will be assigned a technical score out of a maximum of 100 marks.Minimum of 75 marks must be secured by bidder to qualify. Only the bidders who getan aggregate technical score of 75 marks or more will qualify for commercial evaluation stage. Failing to secure minimum marks shall lead to technical rejection of the Bid and Bidder.

7.1.3 Stage 3: Commercial Evaluation

- a) All the technically qualified bidders will be notified to participate in Commercial Bid opening process. The commercial bids will be opened tier wise in presence of the bidders qualified for Tier 1 and Tier 2 respectively.
- b) The commercial bids for the technically qualified bidders will then be opened on the notified date and time and reviewed to determine whether the commercial bids are substantially responsive. Bids that are not substantially responsive are liable to be disqualified at Capacity Building Commission's discretion.
- c) The bid price will include all taxes and levies and shall be in Indian Rupees and mentioned separately. Taxes will be paid/reimbursed as per the terms of the Agreement.
 - d) Any conditional bid would be rejected.
 - e) Errors & Rectification: Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis:
 - (f) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected.
 - (g) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail."
 - (h) If the Bidder does not accept the error correction, its Bid will be rejected and, the bidder shall stand disqualified from bidding for any contract with CBC for a periodof one year from the date of notification.

Stage 4: Empanelment of successful bidder through LCS

- 1. Bidders will be classified in two tiers- I and II as in Para 7.1 above.
- 2. Only 1 proposal will be accepted from one firm.
- 3. Bidders may check their eligibility in accordance with the pre-qualification criterion and apply accordingly with relevant supporting documents.

- 4. DPIIT recognized startups are exempted from some of the pre-qualification criterion and may apply for Tier- II.
- 5. Agencies applying under Tier-2 will be required to submit their recognition certificate.
- 6. The technical parameters for evaluation of the bidders shall remain the same for bidders applying in both the tiers.
- 7. Tier wise financial bids of only for technically qualified bidders will be opened.
- 8. For Tier 1, the technically qualified bidders of Tier 1 will be required to match the least cost shared by any of the Tier-1 bidders, to be empaneled in Tier 1 category.
- 9. For Tier 2, the technically qualified bidders of Tier 2 will be required to match the least cost shared by any of the Tier-2 bidders, to be empaneled in Tier 2 category.
- 10. On successful matching the least cost, the bidders will be empaneled in the Tier 1 and Tier 2 categories, respectively.
- 11. If a Bidder quotes NIL charges / consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
- 12. Abnormally low financial bids will be handled as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India (https://doe.gov.in/sites/default/files/Predatory%20pricing%20%20Abnormally%20Low%20 Bids.pdf) and for predatory pricing and abnormally low bids evaluations. And any conditional bid would be rejected.
- 13. CBC reserves the right to terminate the empanelment for reasons of non performance
