I. Overview

The Commission conducted capacity-building activities and institutional coordination engagements during
September and October 2025, with emphasis on developing indigenous case-based learning resources, strengthening state-level implementation frameworks under Mission Karmayogi and supporting institutionalisation of continuous training infrastructure.

II. Key Initiatives

1. Second Edition of Advanced Case Writing Workshop - The Second Edition of the Advanced Case Writing Workshop (2025–26) was conducted in September 2025 for 80 participants, primarily faculty from various CTIs and ATIs, and focused on building their case writing skills. The workshop was organised in three cohorts:

Held in collaboration with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Asian Development Bank Institute (ADBI), the workshop was led by faculty from Stanford Leadership Academy for Development (LAD) and IIT Delhi.

2. Rashtriya Karmayogi Jan Seva Program - AIIMS Delhi - The second batch of Master Trainers under the Rashtriya Karmayogi Jan Seva Program were addressed by the commission members on 9th September, 2025, highlighting the program's vision of nurturing Seva Bhav (spirit of service) and Svadharma (sense of duty) among civil servants at AIIMS New Delhi.

- 3. Inauguration of Capacity Building Unit (CBU) and E-Learning Centre at The Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research (JIPMER) The CBU and E-Learning Centre at JIPMER were formally inaugurated on 19th September 2025 to advance the structured implementation of Mission Karmayogi. Equipped with state-of-the-art IT infrastructure, the Centre can accommodate 40–50 participants and is supported by JIPMER's in-house TV Studio, developed by BECIL in 2018.
- 4. Capacity Building Commission Meets Hon'ble Governor of Manipur and Signs Tripartite MoU with Govt. of Manipur Capacity Building Commission, engaged with the Hon'ble Governor of Manipur, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla ji, to discuss the state's engagement with Mission Karmayogi. The conversation highlighted how Mission Karmayogi is equipping civil servants across India with the competencies, mindset, and values needed for citizen-centric governance.

Following the meeting, a tripartite MoU was signed on 23rd September, 2025 between the Capacity Building Commission, Karmayogi Bharat, and the Government of Manipur. The MoU marked the beginning of an institutional partnership to implement Mission Karmayogi's vision of a competency-based, technology-driven, and continuous learning ecosystem for government officials in Manipur.

- 5. Two Day Workshop on Developing State-Level Capacity Building Plans Capacity Building Commission in collaboration with the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy Of Administration (LBSNAA), organized a 2-day workshop with Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs) to strengthen the development of role-specific Capacity Building Plans (CBPs) for State Departments at CSOI, Vinay Marg, New Delhi on 24th September, 2025. The workshop was inaugurated by Hon'ble MoS (PP) Dr Jitendra Singh. Closing session of the 2-day workshop on 'Developing State-Level Capacity Building Plans' culminated with presentations by ATIs on six key sectors: Education, Women & Child Development, Agriculture, Rural Development, Health and Urban Development at Ambedkar Bhawan, New Delhi.
- 6. Tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Capacity Building Commission (CBC), the School of Ultimate Leadership (SOUL), and the Government of Gujarat The MoU was signed on 1st October, 2025 to launch the District Karmayogi Program-an initiative aimed at strengthening citizen-centric governance. Through this collaboration, CBC, in partnership with the

Government of Gujarat and SOUL, will implement the program in Narmada district. The initiative seeks to empower frontline officials to deliver public services with empathy, responsiveness, and accountability, embodying the true spirit of Seva Bhav (service-mindedness) and ensuring governance that reaches every citizen at the last mile.

- 7. Tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Capacity Building Commission (CBC), Karmayogi Bharat and Government of Nagaland In a significant step toward modernizing governance and enhancing the skills of state officials, the Government of Nagaland signed an MoU on 8th October, 2024 with the Capacity Building Commission and Karmayogi Bharat to implement the Mission Karmayogi initiative in the state. The agreement, inked at the Capital Convention Hall, marked a major stride in aligning Nagaland's administrative framework with the Centre's vision for a future-ready civil service.
- **8. Second Samuhik Charcha at Capacity Building Commission -** On 10th October 2025, the Capacity Building Commission hosted the second edition of Samuhik Charcha, a collective dialogue inspired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of fostering shared learning and reflection across institutions.

The session, themed "Artificial Intelligence and Seva Bhav," explored the opportunities and challenges of integrating Artificial Intelligence (AI) into citizencentric governance. The discussion aimed to understand participants' perspectives on the intersection of AI and Seva Bhav, and to deliberate on how this relationship can be meaningfully nurtured to enhance public service delivery.

- **9.** CBC Hosts Interactive Session to Reflect on the Journey So Far and the Way Forward The Capacity Building Commission (CBC) hosted an interactive session with senior stakeholders and colleagues on 15th October, 2025 at CSOI, KG Marg to reflect on CBC's journey since its inception and to chart the future roadmap for building a competency-driven civil service under Mission Karmayogi. The engaging discussion reaffirmed the collective commitment to strengthening public service capacity across the nation.
- **10.** Two-Day Workshop to Strengthen the Mission Karmayogi Team Capacity Building Commission (CBC), in collaboration with Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) and Karmayogi Bharat, organized a 2-day

workshop at Haryana Institute of Public Administration (HIPA) on 16th and 17th October, 2025, to strengthen the understanding and implementation of Mission Karmayogi at the state level. The workshop focused on building capacity-building perspectives in states, navigating public systems, and enabling AMs/PCs to jointly design state-specific R&R and action plans. Participants also engaged in case-based and real-life simulations to translate concepts into practical strategies for state-level reform.

11. Five lakh officials trained under the Rashtriya Karmayogi – Large Scale Jan Seva Programme - Under Mission Karmayogi, 5,00,000 officials across India have been trained to deliver governance with Seva Bhav at its core. The journey ahead envisions empowering 7,00,000 officials nationwide - building a civil service that is citizen-focused, technology-enabled, and driven by continuous learning.
