SUSTAINED INSTITUTIONAL COMMITMENT TOWARDS VIKSIT BHARAT

Sādhana Saptah 2026 marks an important evolution in the journey of continuous learning under Mission Karmayogi. For the first time, States and Union Territories joined as full partners, extending the learning movement to public servants across every level of governance. This transition from a Central Government initiative to a whole-of-government capability building endeavour reflects a fundamental truth: citizens do not experience governance through institutional boundaries; they experience it as one system. Widespread participation across, States/UTs, Ministries, Departments and institutions, driven by a genuine sense of ownership, reflects the depth of commitment that this mission has inspired across government.

Our learning engagements were guided by the themes of Technology, Tradition, and Tangible Outcomes. The strong engagement with AI-focused learning reflected a growing preparedness for future governance challenges and underscored the importance of technology as an enabler of more responsive and informed public service. At the same time, our Indian Knowledge Systems carrying enduring wisdom in governance, community stewardship, and public ethics were woven into the fabric of our learning endeavour, not as a separate thread but as a living presence. Through thematic webinars, Samuhik Charchas, and expert dialogues, knowledge moved beyond institutional boundaries and became a shared national conversation. The theme of Tangible Outcomes kept us anchored to what matters most: that the quality of governance, as experienced by citizens, is the true measure of all capacity building.

The insights, networks, and momentum built during this Saptah must not remain confined to a single week. Ministries and States are already incorporating these learnings into their annual capacity building plans, strengthening training institutions, and embedding citizen-centric outcomes within their performance frameworks. The ambition of Viksit Bharat by 2047 demands sustained institutional commitment, and *Sādhana* Saptah is a meaningful step in that direction. This report has been prepared as a reflection of the collective learning journey and the experiences that emerged from *Sādhana* Saptah 2026. It is intended to capture the key engagements, outcomes, and insights of the week, with the objective of informing and strengthening future capacity building efforts across government.

The Capacity Building Commission places on record its sincere appreciation to all who contributed to making *Sādhana* Saptah 2026 a moment of national institutional significance: the State and Union Territories, the Central Ministries and Departments for their commitment and coordination; and for their wholehearted participation; our training institutions, content creators, and knowledge partners for enriching this ecosystem; and every public servant who invested in their own learning. As India advances towards Viksit Bharat, our progress will be measured not only by what we build, but by how we learn, how we serve, and how we strengthen our institutions together.

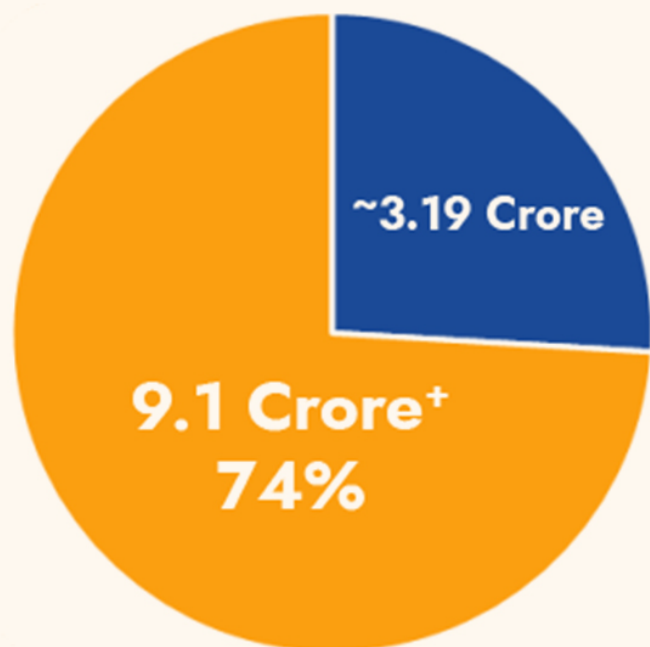

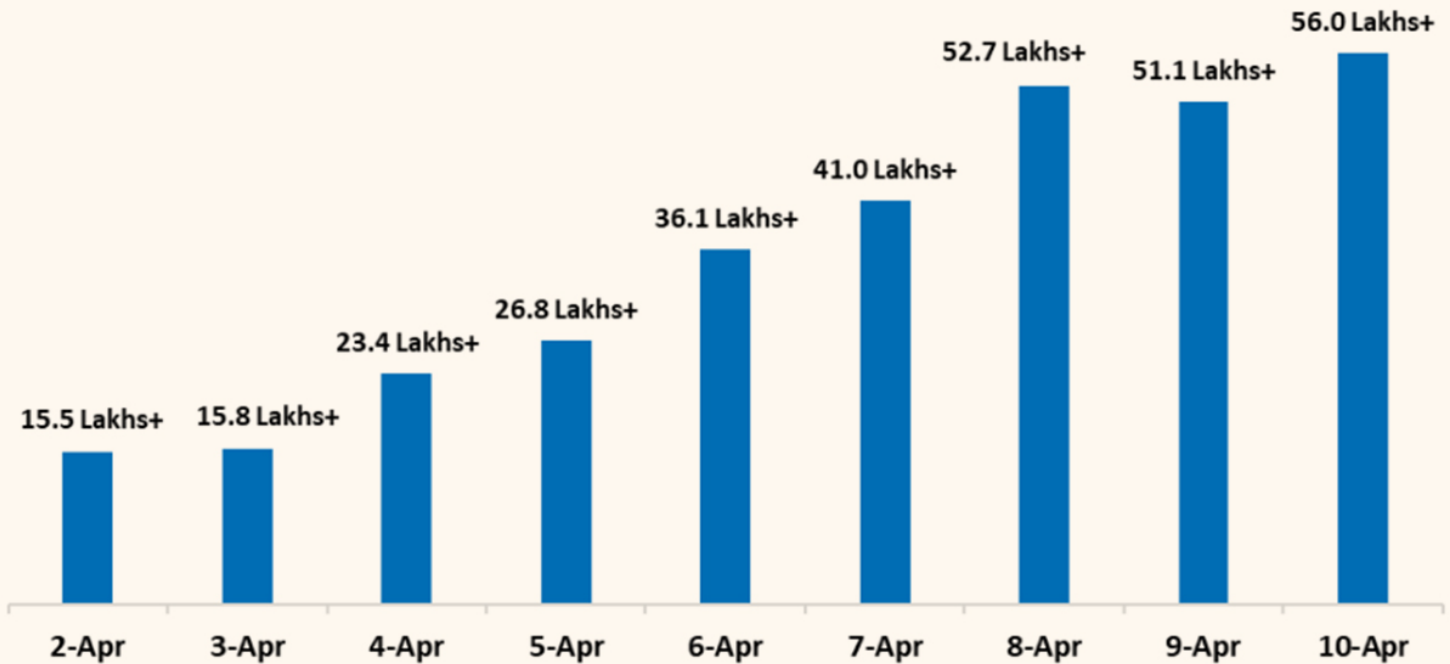

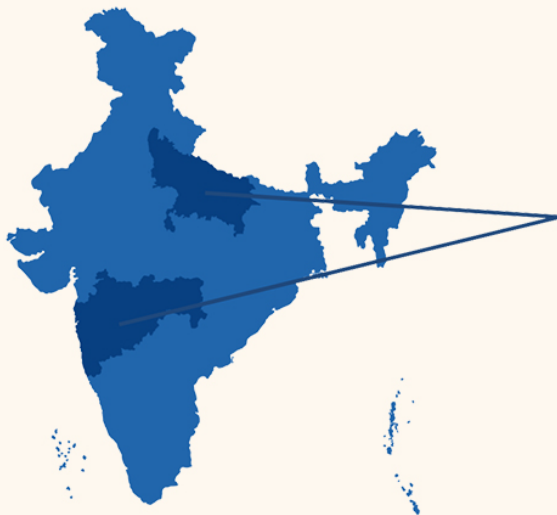

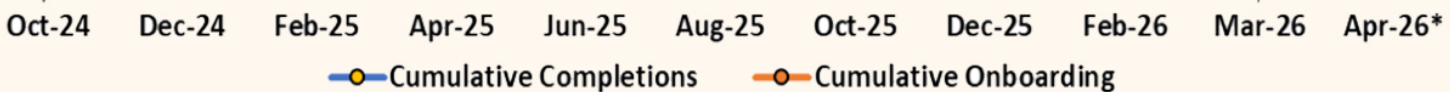

ENCOURAGEMENT FROM THE HON'BLE PM

Over a period of one week, your zeal and Sadhana have been commendable. I am confident that this collective learning movement has ignited a new energy within our civil services.

What has made me very happy is the scale of Sadhana Saptah 2026. It is a delight to see this being marked on an unprecedented scale of engagement, recording over 3.1 crore course completions by over 46 lakh learners, of whom about 33.4 lakh learners completed more than four hours of learning. This represents an eight-fold increase in learning over the last National Learning Week. This surge was complemented by 136 thematic webinars and 84 Samuhik Charchas focused on the themes of technology, traditions and tangible outcomes, drawing participation from over 16.4 lakh learners.


This momentum has been mainly propelled by the State and UT governments, whose employees contributed to over 78% of all course completions. It is particularly heartening to note that a significant number of front-line workers including teachers, police constables and other field workers from the States engaged in learning over the iGOT portal for the first time during the Saptah and contributed over 1.48 Crore course completions during the week. Equally encouraging is the fact that more than 36.6 lakh learners have so far completed at least one AI course on the platform and about 22.8 lakh learners have acquired the AI Daksh badge (for advanced AI focused learning), indicating a strong commitment towards future-readiness and a growing institutional preparedness for AI adoption in governance.

By the time you receive this letter, you would have returned to your daily duties. But I want you to carry forward the core pillars that define our journey in the week gone by. During this Saptah, you experienced the power of learning together. I urge you to continue breaking the silos within your departments. We must move away from the old mindset of working in isolation and embrace a 'whole-of-government' approach. Remember, the progress of India is the sum of our collective victories across every state and every department. Let the spirit of team building you practiced this week become the permanent culture of your office. Use the digital tools and data driven insights you have explored to make governance more efficient and citizen centric. The principle of 'Nagrikdevo Bhava' must be at the heart of every decision.

We must remember that earlier the yardstick was to be better than the past. But now, it has changed. The whole nation is energised by the vision of building Viksit Bharat. Now, our yardstick should be to evaluate all our efforts based on the aim of creating a developed nation by 2047.
