








B. V. R. Subrahmanyam

He was honored with the prestigious Rajyotsava Award by the Government of Karnataka. He has also received the Performance Excellence Award from ISRO for his role in the realization of GSLV Mk-III. He was felicitated with the esteemed K.P.P. Nambiar Award, reflecting his invaluable contributions to the field of space technology and research.





Suhas Lalinakere Yathiraj

Suhas Lalinakere Yathiraj is an Indian para-badminton player and the World No.1 in men's singles. He graduated in Computer Science and Engineering from the National Institute of Technology (NIT), Surathkal. Beyond his distinguished civil service career, Suhas made history as the first IAS officer to win a Paralympic medal by securing a silver at the Tokyo 2020 Paralympics. His sporting achievements have earned him numerous accolades, including the Arjuna Award and the recognition of being ranked among the top para-badminton players globally. Suhas's dedication to both governance and sports exemplifies his commitment to excellence, resilience, and inspiring leadership.



Abhinav Bindra

Bindra's historic gold medal win in the 10m air rifle event at the 2008 Beijing Olympics marked a defining moment in Indian sports history. He has held significant key roles including membership in the International Olympic Committee's Athletes' Commission and being a part of the Athletes' Advisory Committee of the Indian Olympic Association. Abhinav's contributions to sports have earned him the prestigious Padma Bhushan and Arjuna Award. He continues to inspire future generations through his commitment to excellence, resilience, and the development of India's sporting ecosystem.



Vikram Misri


Amritanshu Pandey


B.K. Shivani
